Do you have any of the following symptoms: (Check all that apply)

- Fever/feverish (Temperature 100.4°F or greater)
- chills,
- sore throat,
- dry cough,
- difficulty breathing, or
- digestive symptoms such as diarrhea, vomiting, and abdominal pain?
- Have you traveled internationally/outside of Michigan within the last 14 days?
- Have you had close contact with a confirmed/probable COVID-19 case?
- Have you had close contact with a person with acute respiratory illness who has been outside Michigan in the last 14 days?

If the answer is NO to all questions, they have passed the screening and can enter the building.

“You’re cleared to enter the building. Please use the hand sanitizer/wash hands before you proceed in. Also, you are required to wear a mask coving your mouth and nose while you are in the building. Thank you for your patience and enjoy the rest of your day.”

If the answer is YES (Checked the box) to any screening questions, or refuses to answer, they failed the screening. Keep the employee away from others and they are not permitted to enter the building.

“I’m sorry but based on these answers, we’re not able to let you enter the building today.”
